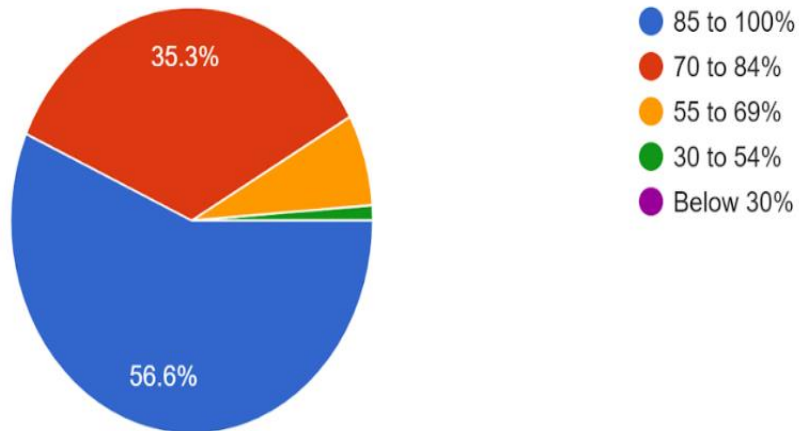

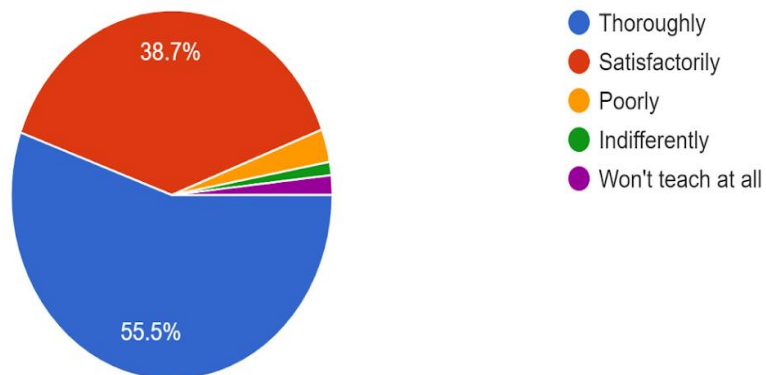

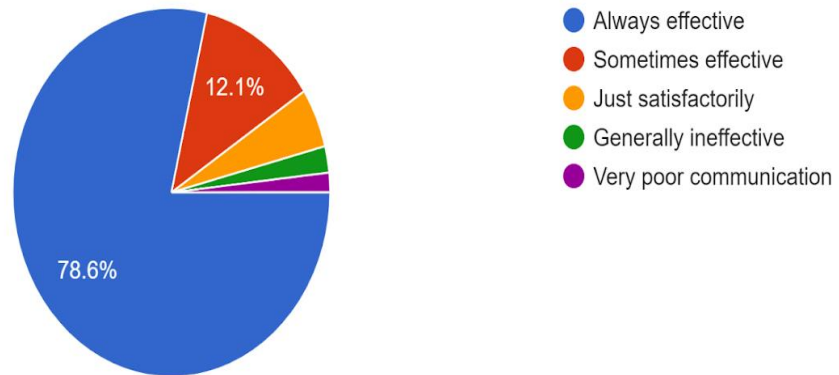
2) How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

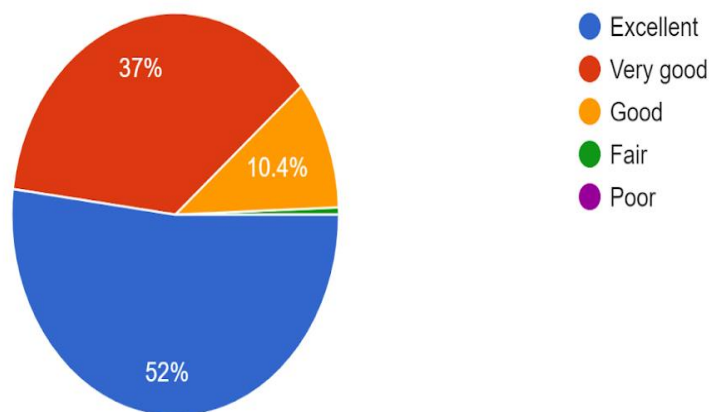

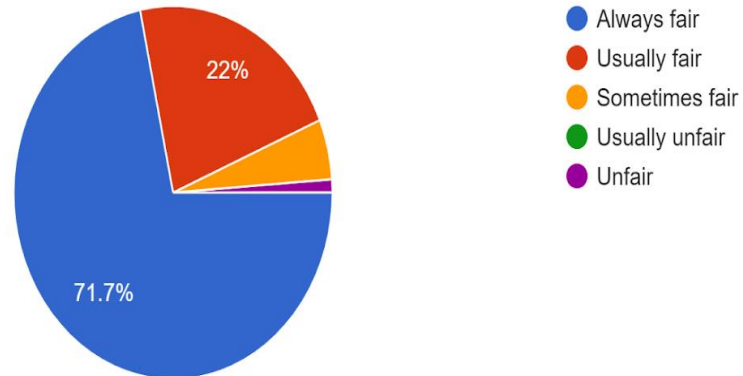

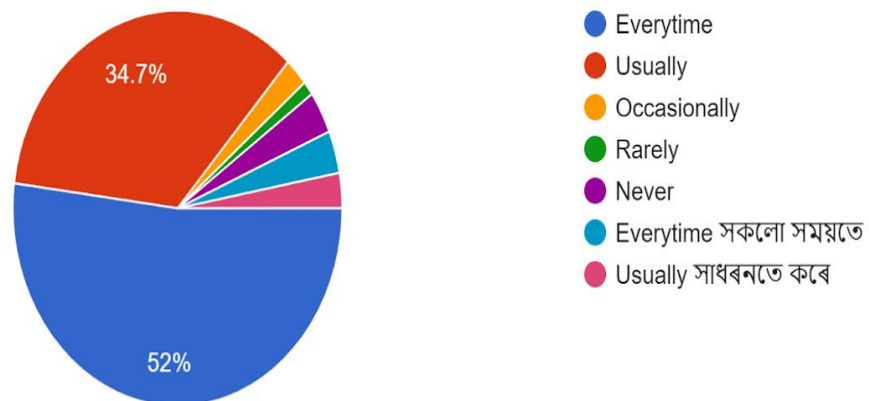

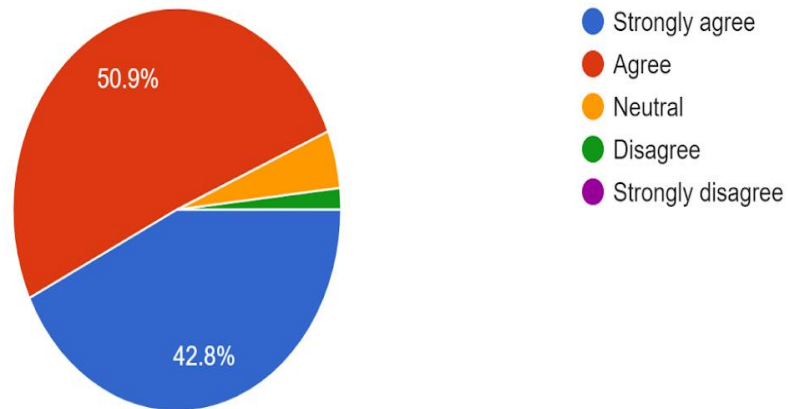
6) Was your performance in assignments discussed with you

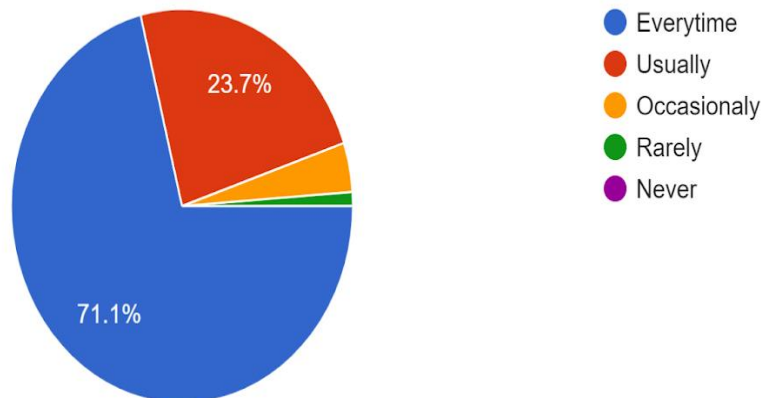

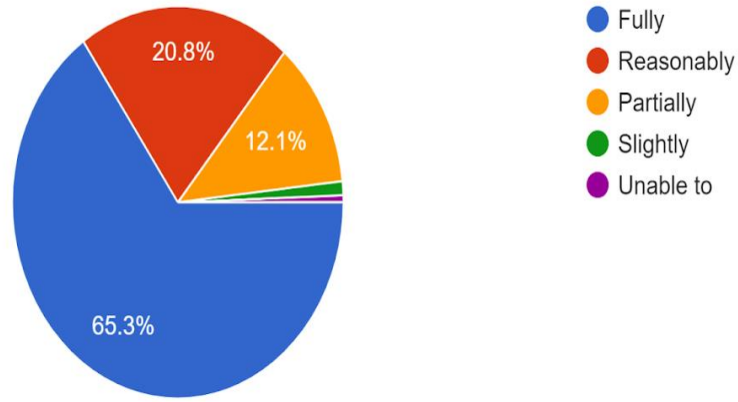

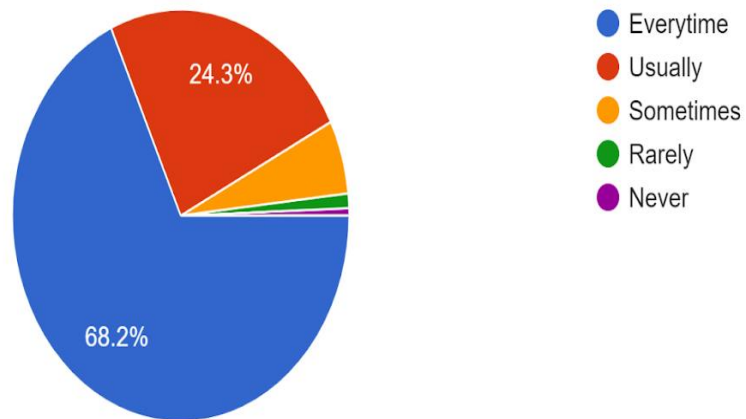

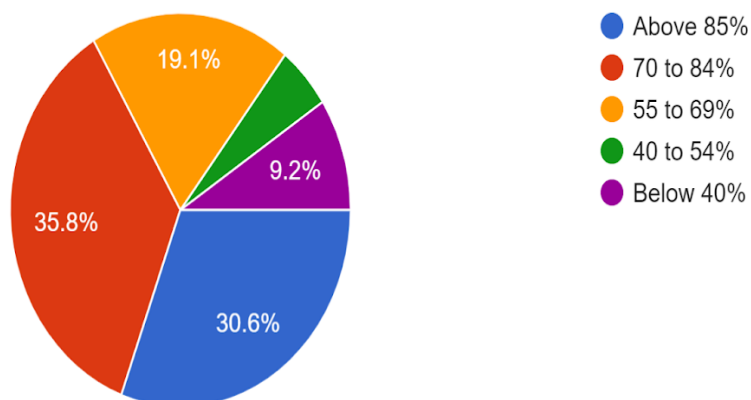

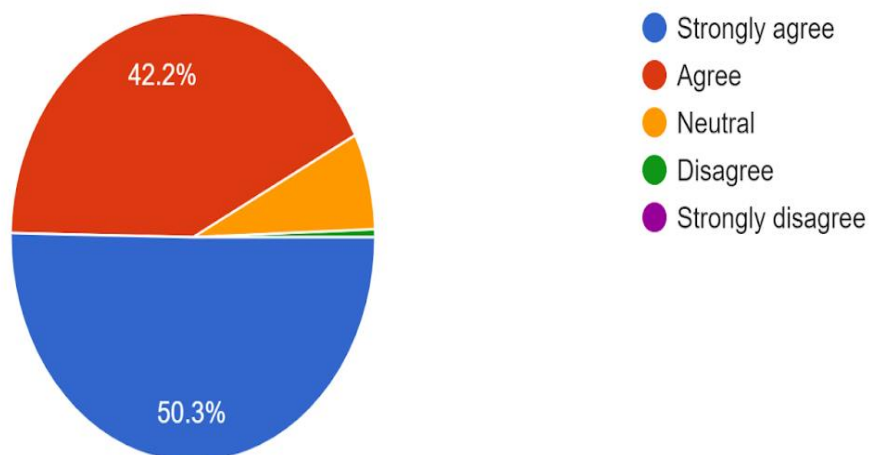

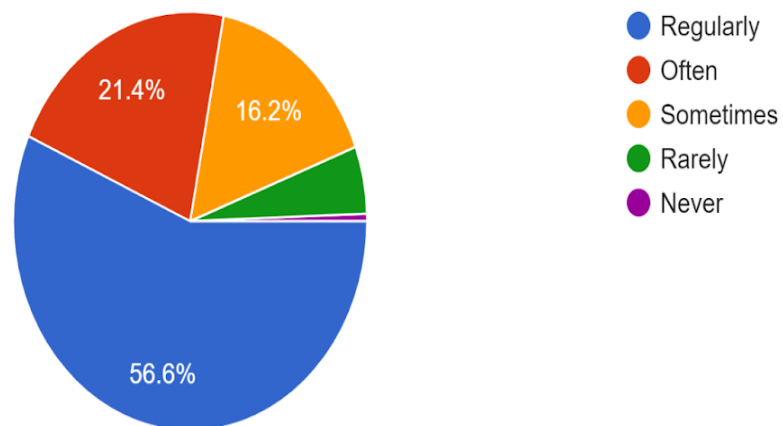

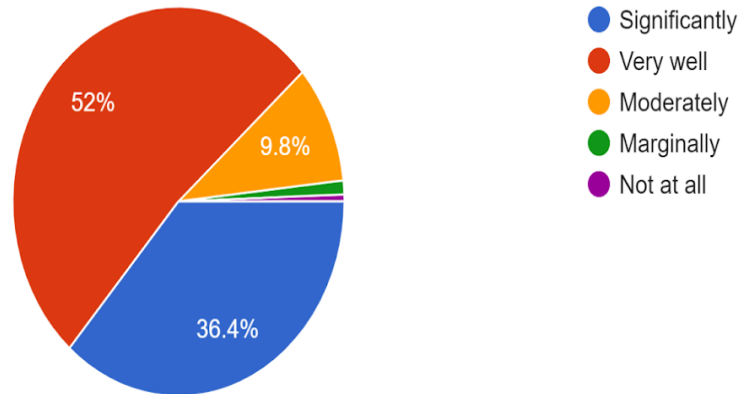

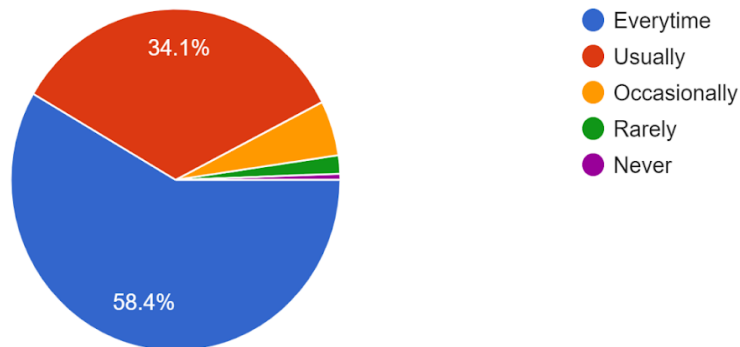
