Policy Documents on GREEN CAMPUS/ PLASTIC FREE

The green campus initiative offers an opportunity to take the lead in redefining its environmental culture and protect the ecosystem. The Green Campus and Environment Policy will develop exciting new co-curricular and extracurricular practices that encourage students and staff to take the lead in creating positive change. Kamrup College, Chamata is conscious about environment conservation with its green campus initiatives and maintains pollution free and clean campus. The main focus areas for Green Campus Policy are:

Objectives of the Policy:

1.To protect and conserve ecological systems and resources within the campus.

2.To ensure efficient use of environmental sources to meet the needs and aspirations of the present and future generations.

3.To integrate environmental concerns into policies, plans and programs for social development.

4.To make the campus plastic free.

5.To conduct Environmental and Energy audit.

1. Landscaping Initiatives with trees and plants: Sustainable infrastructure is a vital part of the college campus, providing space for study, play, outdoor events, relaxation and aesthetic appreciation.




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Green campus and landscape also helps to recharge ground water, clean and cool air in campus. There are number of trees, medicinal plants on campus along with green grass cover. Green cover of college is home for number of insects and bird species.

2. Clean Campus Initiatives: In accordance to Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, College has committed to actively coordinate cleanliness activities in the college and beyond the campus. Supporting staff are appointed for the maintenance of clean and Green Campus. These initiatives include:-Generating mass awareness on cleanliness and hygiene amongst students and staff members by holding regular cleanliness drives, Activities under 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' is a key component of all the community works being done by NSS, Teaching faculties and staff members are encouraged to participate in the cleanliness drives, Commit to manage waste and maintain clean campus especially during college events and Conduct various Environment awareness days and tree plantation program.

3. Clean Air Initiatives: College encourages student and staff to use public transportation.




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Also encourage for carpooling, an activity that will control air pollution and strengthen social interaction. Smoking and burning of garbage strictly prohibited in campus. The abundant natural landscape cleans the air in campus.

4. Infrastructure: The college believes in reducing the consumption of electricity by utilizing grid connected PV Solar system with net metering. Installation of Energy efficient equipment College commits to install environment-friendly electrical appliances that save energy and reduce wastage of energy. Most of the tube lights and lamps are replaced by LEDs in classrooms and passages to minimize the energy consumption.

5) Waste Management Processes

a) Liquid waste management

1. Maintain leak proof water fixtures.
2. Continued employment of a caretaker to take immediate steps to stop any water leakage through taps, pipes, tanks, and toilet flush etc.




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3.By treating waste water generated in washrooms through Sewage Treatment Plant (STP).

b) Solid waste management

The college will adopt practices to mitigate the generation and manage solid waste through the following methods:

1. Systematically engage with the 3Rs (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle) for eco - friendly environment.
2. Collect paper waste in campus and sent for recycling
3. Take initiatives to spread awareness among students about: Food wastage and ways of minimizing it, Minimizing the use of packaged food and Use of degradable waste for composting purpose.
4. College also signed in MOU with **25 no. Rupiabathan Gaon Panchayat under Paschim Nalbari Development Block for the purpose of solid waste management.** They collect the solid wastes from the college in every month




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c) E-waste management

College ensures that its usage of technology and generation of e-waste does not impact the environment. For this purpose, the college plans to strive towards:

Awareness amongst students about reduction of e-waste and making provisions for environment friendly disposal

College also signed **MOU with NEXAS computer, Islamsupa Nalbari** to facilitate E-wastes (Selling & buying) collection from Kamrup College

6) Environment Centric Awareness Activities

College encourages awareness programs, Swaccha Abhiyan, Donation of handmade bamboo dustbin, use of earthen lamp during festival, plantation program inside and outside the campus, Cycle rally for environmental Awareness, sapling distributions, Cleanliness drive in and beyond the campus, Celebration of Various Environmental days.




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7) Green/Environment Audit

The college aims to conduct a Green Audit to assess strengths and weaknesses for long term sustainability. Green audit were conducted **by ASTEC**, Guwahati. A green audit is a useful tool to determine how and where most energy or water resources are being used. The college can then consider how to implement changes and make savings. It can determine the type and volume of waste. Green auditing will promote financial savings through reduction in the use of resources. It is imperative that the college evaluate its own contributions toward a sustainable future.

8) Energy Audit

An Energy Audit is carried out to reduce carbon foot print. The Energy audit were conducted by Assam Engineering College, Guwahati in 2024. The energy audit, with its specialized tools will identify wastage of energy. Such an inspection often reveals several different flaws which cause a loss of significant amounts of energy which the college will not be able to detect.




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These flaws often have easy and affordable solutions and provide significant savings.

9) Plastic free campus

In view of the Government of India's resolution to ban all single use plastics due to the hazardous impact of plastic use and pollution, the college administration strictly bans the use of single use plastics in its premise to make it a 'Plastic Free Campus'

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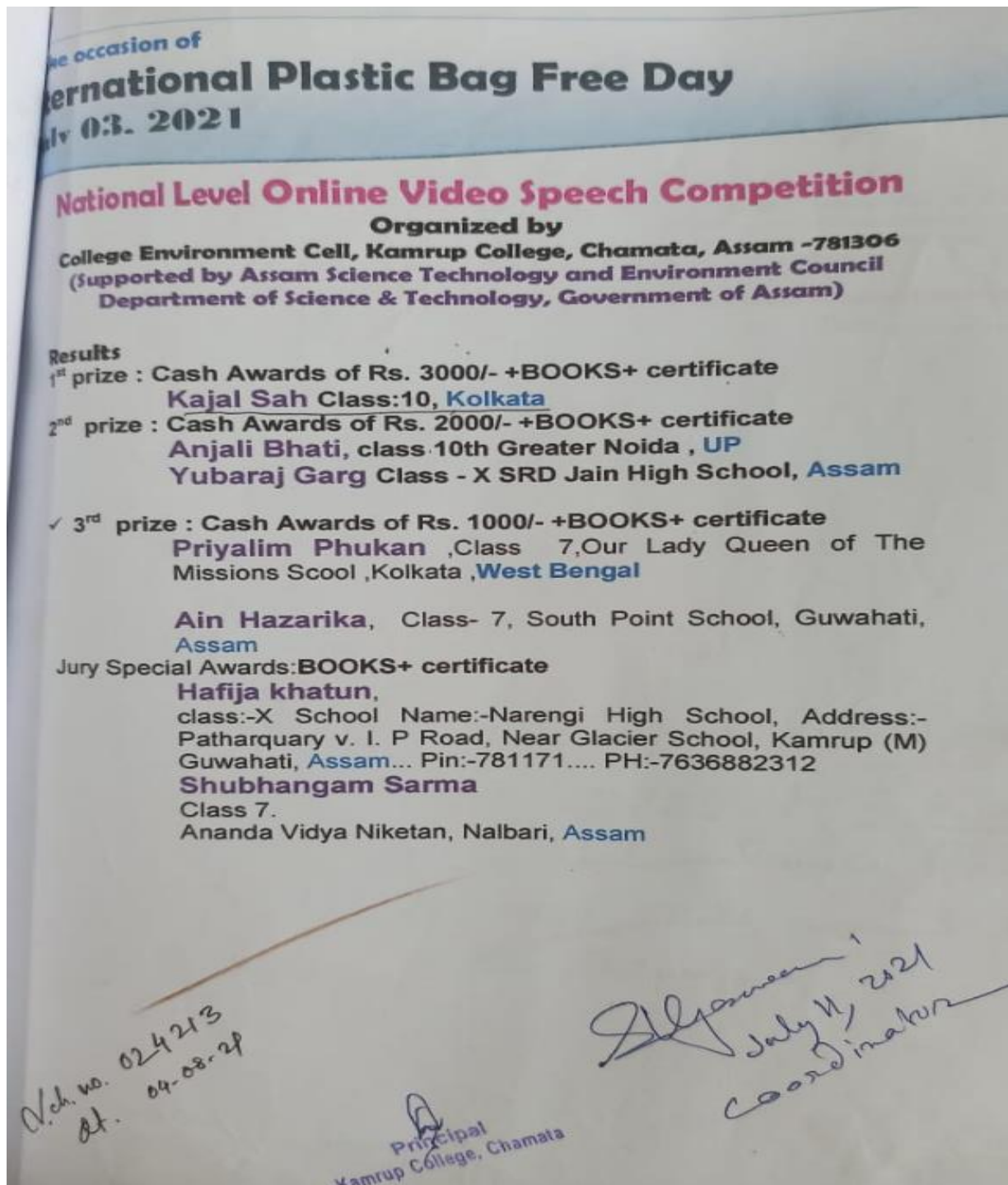

25 No Rupiyabathan Gaon Panchayat, Vill- Rupiyabathan, P.O – Chamata, PIN-781306, Paschim Nalbari Dev Block collects non-biodegradable waste from the college, hostels, and staff quarters to shredding units for recycling as per the collection calendar of the Government of Assam. The waste is segregated into different sections based on its features.

The FIRST party and SECOND party have made this Memorandum of Understanding for Waste management under following terms and Conditions-

1. To facilitate the collection and transportation of solid waste, e-waste from the college, which is a vital element in the protection of the environment. Whereas Kamrup College has agreed to give away the e-waste, solid wastes of plastic, paper and glass generated in the college. The collection of these recyclables from Kamrup College, Chamata will be initiated as per schedule, where both the parties agreed mutually.
2. The MoU will be Valid for a period of 5(five) years before renewal.
3. **TERMINATION**:- Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing written termination notice of its intention to terminate the MoU to the other party.
4. **MODIFICATION**:- The parties may change or modify the terms and this agreement only by written amendment signed by both the parties.
5. **SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES**:- Any disputes concerning interpretation and application of this MoU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the parties. In witness whereof the Parties here to duly executed this presents on the day, month and year herein above first mentioned.

DEFINED TERMS IN THIS AGREEMENT

Solid Waste: Plastics, wood, metals, glass, leather, sanitary waste in septic tanks and other wastes. **E-waste**: electrical and electronic equipment which Includes-Computers & Peripherals (CPU, Keyboard, Mouse& Monitor) b. Laptops, **Paper Waste**: Discarded paper including cardboard, newspaper, magazines, shredded paper, office records, notebooks, etc. **Plastic waste**: Polythene shets, carry bags, bottles, bottle caps, food wrappers, dust bin papers straws and stirrers, etc. **Glass waste**: Bottles, bottle caps, bulbs, jars, etc.
