A five days workshop was organized in the college from 17th to 21st February,2022. For this purpose "Prahar".a leading organization of the state in Martial Art was invited to provide the training in Tau-k-Wando and Karate to the girls students of our college. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. Bhabendra Nath Pathak, President Governing Body, Kamrup College, Chamata. In his inaugural speech, he highly appreciated such endeavors undertaken by the IQAC and Women's Cell in context of the growing crimes against the women in our society.Dr. Debendra Kr. 8. Workshop cum Training programme on Nursery development at Daffodil College of Horticulture

FROM KAMRUP COLLEGE TO DAFFODILD NURSERY AND DAFFODILS COLLEGE OF HORTICULTURE

As part of extension activities, IQAC, Kamrup College, Chamata undertook a students' Exposure programme to Daffodils Nursery and Daffodils College of Horticulture, Khetri of Kamrup District on 8th of April, 2022. A group of teachers along with principal, Dr. Debendra Kumar Bezbaruah accompanied the students. The Daffodil Nursery, one of the best and leading plant nurseries in the entire North East India, was established in the year 1985 having two stars nursery. The nursery is run by Dr. Dhrubajyoti Sarma an Associate professor and one of the leading entrepreneurs of the state and his wife Mrs. Rekha Sarma. Today the plants of the nursery are exported to all over India. Moreover many foreign countries like Bhutan, Bangkok etc. also import plants from the nursery. The nursery has grown into a big enterprise with verities of reliable flowering plants, fruits plants and vegetable, flower seeds, grafts, specially the rubber grafts and many other plants which are only available in abroad. More than 300 people are working in this nursery who work hard to provide the best quality plants . They also help young people to set small and medium nursery of their own by providing plants from the nursery. The Nursery family adopted a nearby village which was very poor and earning less . But with the proper training and entrepreneurial spirit Daffodil Nursey transformed it into a self-depended village as every family had begun to develop nursery plantation under the supervision of Daffodils Nursery.

Our day long programme was divided into two parts. At the beginning the students were introduced to the varieties of plants and their process of plantation. An open air lecture was delivered by Dr. Dhrubajyoti Sarma. His deliberation enthralled the students very much. They gathered a wide range of first-hand knowledge on Nursery cultivation and nursery management. They are also made known by today's exposure programme that in this time of job scarcity nursery plantation can be a great opportunity for their earning.

In the second part of our visit we went to the Mother Plant Block which is located at Amguri where we have noticed around 18 certified mother plants out of 300 mother plants. We were happy to visit the nursery and at the same time our students learnt how to plant and care the plants and to make the spaces around us green and beautiful. After the visit of Daffodil Nursery and Mother Plant Block, the team went to visit Daffodil Horticulture College. The institution is providing quality education in a unique natural environment. An interactive session was held with the faculty members of the institution to encourage our students for generating interest in entrepreneurship through extra-curricular practices. Honourable Prof. H.C. Bhattacharyya delivered a speech on how to impart higher education in horticulture and how this enables the youths to become a successful entrepreneur.

After the presentation session, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was also signed between the two institutions for future collaboration in both academic and entrepreneurship sectors.

the Department of Education & Department of Economics, Kamrup College, Chamata in collaboration with Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Kamrup College, Chamata

Date: 07-13 November 2022

A one-week faculty development programme organised by the Department of Education & Department of Economics in collaboration with IQAC, Kamrup College on "Research Methodology and Academic Publication (Interdisciplinary)" was held at Kamrup College, Chamata from 7th November, 2022 to 13th November, 2022. The programme focused on refreshing and upgrading the research skills of the participants at different stages in their respective academic careers across a diverse set of academic disciplines. The objective of the program was to enhance and expand the knowledge base of the participants in academic writing and publishing; research methodology; literature review; research ethics; data types; sampling and modelling; data collection and analysis techniques; plagiarism, journal indexing, etc.

Day 1: DATE: 7th November 2022 Inaugural Session:

The session started with the ceremony of lightning of lamp by Dr. B.N. Pathak, Retd. faculty of the Department of Economics, Kamrup College, Chamata and current President of Governing Body, Kamrup College, Chamata. This was followed by a welcome address to the participants by Dr. D. Bezbaruah, Principal, Kamrup College, Chamata. On behalf of the organising committee and IQAC, Kamrup College, Dr. Biswajit Das explained the objectives behind the programme aimed at professional development of the participants. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. B.N. Pathak who appreciated the efforts of the organisers by affirming his support in his inaugural speech.

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Inaugural Session

Technical session: I&II Resource person:

Prof. Tarun Chandra Bora,

VC, Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Visvavidyalaya

Prof. Bora presented a talk on the topic "Quality PhD: A presentation from National R&D Institute" with special focus on various works of his team from CSIR-NEIST, Jorhat. His lecture revolved around the rich biodiversity (including animal, plant and microbial diversity) along with the ethnic diversity of the Northeast Indian region, indicating the feasibility of selection of quality PhD topics pertaining to the same. He discussed about the Indo-Burma biodiversity hotspot, the importance of protected forest areas, status of endemic species and discovery of microbial species in Northeast India, simultaneously commenting on the status and scope of good research concerning the issues. During the 'discussions and comments' section following the talk, he offered his critical analysis regarding challenges in sustaining good quality of PhD works in institutes of higher education and nationally funded scientific labs, along with providing valuable comments on social issues such as poaching of endangered animals and illegal trade.

Technical Session: III

Dr. Debnath talked about the latest trends in sampling techniques in the social sciences in his talk titled "Sampling Design". After a brief survey of the diverse research disciplines of the participants, he reviewed the technical terms commonly encountered in data sampling and proceeded to explain the need and purpose of sampling. This was followed by a discussion on the sampling methods and sampling errors. He also highlighted the commonly used techniques for sample size determination.

Technical Session: IV

In this interactive session, Dr. Debnath talked about modelling in research citing practical examples from existing research works. He emphasised on the need for developing good sample survey designs and discussed about the commonly encountered challenges in the data collection process. He proceeded to discuss the various statistical models historically and currently used in social sciences based on the data types and research quotient. In addition, he briefly highlighted the good practices in academic writing and encouraged the participants to follow the same. The session ended with an interactive discussion between the speaker and participants on the use cases of various statistical models and sampling techniques.





Guest Speaker: Dr. Pankaj Namasudra

As a guest speaker, Dr. Pankaj Namasudra spoke on the similarities and differences in the structure of PhD works in the field of cultural studies with that in the fields of social sciences or basic sciences. He focused on the importance of thorough field study in the discipline of cultural studies

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and talked about the challenges met in the process and how to overcome the same citing instances of his first-hand experiences during his PhD research.

Day 3:

Date: 9th November, 2022

Technical Session V:

Dr. Sarma's talk titled "Types of Data and Sources" initially focused on the broader meaning of data subsequently moving towards a statistical description to explain the significance of data in research. He discussed about the types of data and the sources of data used in academic research.

Technical Session VI:

In this session, Dr Sarma talked about the various data analysis methods currently used in social sciences. Capitalising on his experiences as a college administrator, he talked about the scopes and challenges of research among the college faculty in Assam from an administration viewpoint. This was followed by an active discussion on the various features and policies in the National Education Policy-2020 in the context of academic research.







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Day 4:

Date: 10th November, 2022

Resource person: Dr Purabi Baishya

Technical Session VII:

In the talk titled 'Research Methodology in Education', Dr Baishya gave a brief overview of research in general reviewing the meaning and characteristics of research, types of research, criteria for good research as well as desirable qualities of research scholars. She focused on the process of research explaining the steps involved in it. This was followed by a review of research methodology and its types and importance. In continuation, she briefly talked about the sampling design in research methodology, common data collection methods and data analysis methods in social sciences, citing appropriate instances and examples from the discipline of education research. This was followed by an interactive session on research paper formats and common referencing and citation styles in practice.

Technical Session VIII:

Dr Baishya delivered a talk titled "Writing an effective research paper" focusing on good practices in academic writing and commented on its need in the professional growth of faculty in higher educational institutes. The talk focused on the structural organisation of a good academic research paper and ways of choosing good journals for publication. The talk also briefly highlighted ways of checking and avoiding plagiarism in academic writing.





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Day 5:

Date: 11th November, 2022 Speaker: Prof. Sanjay K Singh

Head, Department of Library and Information Science, Gauhati University

Technical Session IX:

In his talk titled "Publication and Journal Indexing", Prof. S. K Singh briefly reviewed ethics in research followed by a thorough discussion on journal indexing, indexing bodies and various types of academic publications. He commented on the steps of the process of publishing a paper and provided comments and suggestions for choosing quality topics for publication and selecting good journals. He also highlighted the peer review process currently in use in the academic publication process. This was followed by a brief discussion on malpractices by journals and suggested ways to avoid cloned journals and predatory journals.

Technical Session X:

The second session comprised of a talk titled "Plagiarism" where Prof. Singh discussed about the practices that qualify as plagiarism in academics and commented on the reasons for the prevalence of plagiarism in academics. He highlighted the common types of plagiarisms citing appropriate examples and talked about the tools to check and prevent plagiarism in academic writing. He also commented on the fair use policies in academic publishing along with ways of intellectual property rights violation. This was followed by a discussion on the consequences and penalties for plagiarism currently in practice in India as per UGC.

Technical Session XI:

Dr. Pathak spoke on the topic "Research Ethics" by first reviewing the terminologies related to the topic of research in general, thereby proceeding to a detailed discussion of ethics in research. He highlighted the basic principles of ethics and explained the major ethical principles and codes in detail citing appropriate examples. He also talked in detail about ethics in the process of academic publishing and presented remarks on associated topics such as intellectual property rights, malpractices in assigning authorship, plagiarism and fraud in publishing, malpractices by academic publishing houses such as cloned journals or predatory journals. Finally, he commented on the obligations of individuals or groups involved in research in following and upholding ethical practices and emphasised on the need to follow ethical practices in academics.

Technical Session XII:

In this session, Dr. Pathak delivered a talk on the topic "Literature Review". A brief review of the basic definition and meaning of the term 'literature review' was followed by a discussion of the objectives of literature review and its importance in the field of research. He commented on the prevalent practices of what is included in literature review and the types of sources that are used for the process of literature review. He also commented on the ways of organising and structuring literature review in academic writing as well as on the decisions involved in literature selection and literature review writing. He offered his remarks on what makes a good literature review by revising the aim and purpose of it in research and gaps in the process of literature review. He concluded the session with a discussion on the topic of writing styles and review process in the context of literature review in academic research.
